Cotton: World Markets and Trade

Importers Turn to United States to Lock in Supply



With global stocks the tightest in 15 years, major importers are trying to lock in supplies, despite the unprecedented high prices. Furthermore, export controls by India, the second largest exporter, have raised concerns about its reliability as supplier, resulting in many importers turning to the United States. Consequently, U.S. sales through the first 12 weeks of the marketing year increased dramatically to a record level. Sales are expected to remain strong with the current export forecast of 15.75 million bales (480 lbs) for the year. Foreign buyers are purchasing U.S. cotton in record quantities. The high level of exports is expected to push U.S. stocks to the lowest level since 1925.

Explanation of Changes to USDA's Cotton Supply and Demand Estimates for China, November 2010

World cotton cash and futures prices have surged in the past month, showing extraordinary volatility and exceeding all previous historical records. Several developments have contributed to the run-up in prices, including: declining world production in the three previous seasons; stronger than expected recovery in demand from the 2008-2009 world recession; sharply higher prices for agricultural commodities that compete with cotton for land; restrictions on exports by the government of India; concerns about 2010-crop production in China and Pakistan; the weaker dollar; and speculative pressures. However, the single most important price driver is a supply shortage in China, which has far exceeded expectations and has resulted in recent prices paid to producers of an unprecedented \$2.00 per pound.

In light of developments in China, USDA has made significant revisions to supply and demand for 2009/10 and 2010/11 compared to last month's estimates, as illustrated in the following tables. China's ending stocks for 2009/10 are reduced 3.0 million bales based on the shortages which have become apparent over the past several weeks, indicating minimal inventories available for mills to continue operations. Lower stocks at the end of 2009/10 are the result of stronger consumption than previously projected – consumption is raised 1.0 million bales to 50.0 million, slightly below the pre-recession peak of 2007/08. In addition, USDA has eliminated the China residual for both 2009/10 and 2010/11. The residual was first used in the 1994/95 balance sheet to reconcile statistical discrepancies which had resulted in the understatement of ending stocks and over projection of import requirements. Recent price increases indicate that stocks have likely been overstated, thereby eliminating the need for the residual.

For 2010/11, production is reduced 1.5 million bales from last month, reflecting reductions from the October estimate in both area and yields. With sharply lower domestic supplies stemming from reductions in beginning stocks and production, China's imports are projected 2.0 million bales higher and consumption 3.0 million bales lower. The consumption projection of 47.0 million bales is 6 percent below 2009/10, despite underlying growth in demand for textiles at the consumer level, as limited global supplies and sharply higher prices will force mills either to curtail operations or substitute polyester for cotton. Ending stocks for 2010/11 are now projected at 13.2 million bales, 1.5 million bales below last month's estimate and 28 percent of consumption. This level of stocks implies a need for significant levels of imports during the early months of 2011/12.



Prices

U.S spot prices, which are at the highest levels since the data has been collected, neared \$1.40/lb as export commitments reached record levels for this time of the year. The A-Index reached \$1.55/lb as near panic buying was seen in many markets ahead of large new crop arrivals and deteriorating crop conditions in China.



TRADE CHANGES IN 2010/11

Major Exporters:

- **United States** is raised 250,000 bales to 15.75 million on stronger foreign import demand.
- **Uzbekistan** is raised 150,000 bales to 3.9 million on stronger import demand.
- **Argentina** is raised 125,000 bales to 325,000 on stronger import demand.
- **Australia** is raised 150,000 bales to 2.9 million on expectations of a larger 2011 crop.
- **Brazil** is raised 200,000 bales to 2.4 million due to expectations of a larger 2011 crop.
- **Greece** is lowered 125,000 bales to 875,000 on a smaller 2010 crop.

Major Importers:

- **China** is raised 2.0 million bales to 15.0 million based on a smaller crop and lower carry in, reducing available supply for other importers.
- **Thailand** is lowered 150,000 bales to 1.6 million due to tighter global supply.
- **Mexico** is lowered 100,000 bales to 1.3 million due to tighter supply in the United States.
- **Brazil** is lowered 100,000 bales to 800,000 due to tighter global supply.
- **Turkey** is lowered 100,000 bales to 3.4 million due to tighter global supply.
- **Vietnam** is lowered 150,000 bales to 1.55 million due to tighter global supply.
- **Pakistan** is lowered 100,000 bales to 1.7 million due to tighter global supply.
- **Indonesia** is lowered 200,000 bales to 1.9 million due to tighter global supply.
- **Bangladesh** is lowered 200,000 to 3.95 million due to tighter global supply.

- **Bangladesh** is lowered 200,000 bales to 3.8 million on weaker domestic demand.
