

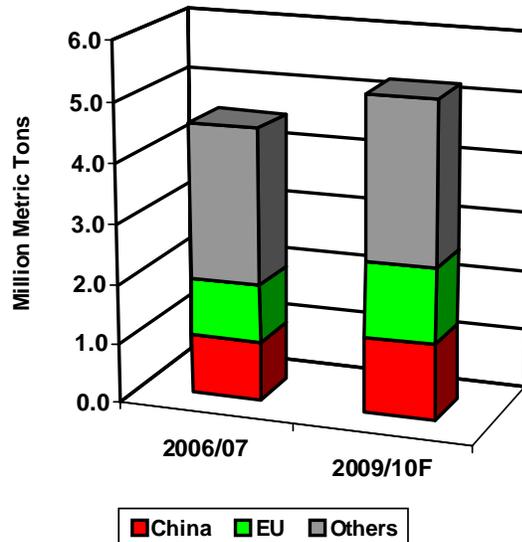
# Fresh Deciduous Fruit (Apples, Pears, & Grapes): World Markets and Trade

December 2009

## APPLES

Global apple exports have jumped 15 percent in just 3 years, with virtually all the growth attributed to China and the European Union (EU). They each gained 30 percent as demand has expanded for healthy snacks and off-season fruit. World production has grown as a result of favorable weather, improved management practices, and new plantings coming into bearing, especially in China.

## 2009/10 Forecast Highlights

- U.S. exports are forecast to gain 6 percent due mainly to robust demand in Asia and the Middle East.
- China, which accounts for over half of world production, is expected to produce almost 10 percent more because new plantings in the northwestern provinces have begun bearing. Its industry is supported through government subsidies and policy guidance, with about \$3.7 million in 2008 provided to farmers in certain areas. The “Layout Plan for China’s Advantageous Products (2008-2015)” provides guidelines for selected products to facilitate processing, stabilize area, increase yields, and expand exports. China is poised to become the world’s largest exporter, bumping the EU to the number two spot. Exports are forecast to surge almost 15 percent on accelerating demand from Asia and the Middle East. Imports are forecast up 10 percent on strong domestic demand for high quality fruit from the United States and off-season products from Chile and other Southern Hemisphere suppliers.
- EU production is forecast down 4 percent resulting from reduced area in Poland and pollination problems in Spain. However, exports are expected to expand 2 percent on continued growing orders by Russia, Ukraine, and other traditional markets.
- Canada’s production is estimated to be moderately higher. Farmers are improving orchards through federal and provincial government programs to replace lower yielding, less popular varieties with higher density plantings of newer varieties. Despite larger domestic supplies, imports are forecast 6 percent higher on anticipated greater purchases of off-season fruits and healthy foods.

- Russia, the world's largest importer, is forecast to buy 4 percent more than the previous year despite a weakening currency and economic problems. More restrictive phytosanitary requirements on EU fruit may present greater export opportunities for U.S. fruit, which mostly compete with high quality EU fruit.

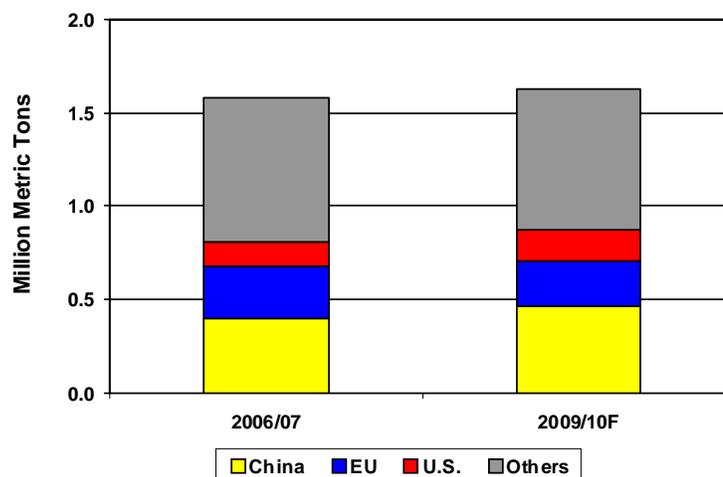
## PEARS

World pear exports are forecast to expand 4 percent due to expected higher demand, particularly by Canada and Russia. Slightly larger world production is predicted, resulting from favorable weather and improved management practices.

### 2009/10 Forecast Highlights

- U.S. pear exports are projected to gain 10 percent on greater purchases by Russia and Brazil.
- EU exports are forecast to climb about 7 percent on continued rising purchases from Norway, Russia, and other traditional markets. In contrast, EU imports are expected to fall slightly as demand is filled by ample domestic supplies.
- China recently unveiled the "Development Plan for Key Pear Production Regions (2009-2015)", which provides financial assistance to improve quality, increase yields, and boost production and exports. China's exports are forecast to rise 5 percent mainly due to growing demand by neighboring Asian markets.
- Canadian cultivated and bearing area is estimated to drop by over one-quarter caused by the closing of Ontario's last cannery. As a result, production is forecast to shrink more than 20 percent and imports to expand about 5 percent, presenting an opportunity for U.S. exporters.
- Russia, the world's largest importer, is likely to purchase 10 percent more due to smaller domestic supplies and higher demand for inexpensive fruit from China and off-season supplies from the southern hemisphere.

**China, EU, and U.S. Account for Half of Global Pear Exports**



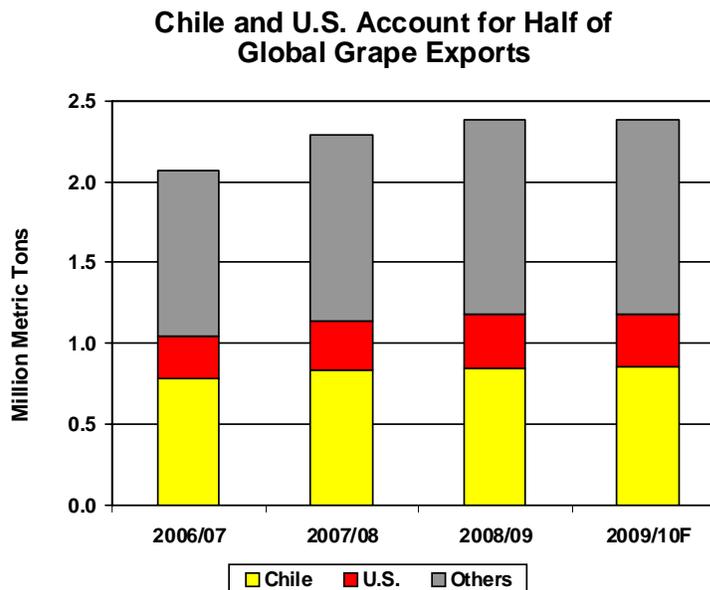
## GRAPES

World trade is projected to remain relatively unchanged.

### 2009/10 Forecast

#### Highlights

- U.S. exports are forecast to slip 4 percent because production fell short and shipments to Mexico plummeted as a result of the 40-percent retaliatory tariffs related to the trucking dispute.
- Chile, Argentina, and South Africa, the world's dominant southern hemisphere exporters, are expected to continue to augment shipments as demand by the northern hemisphere consumers for off-season fruit remains strong.
- The EU accounts for about one-third of world imports, and the economic crisis is expected to reduce imports by almost 4 percent.
