

U.S. Sugar Monthly Import and Re-Exports

Fiscal Year (FY) 2021 - Final Report Updated

November 2021

On October 29, 2021, USDA extended the last date of entry of FY 2021 raw cane sugar TRQ until December 31, 2021, two months later than the previous extension of October 31.

On November 4, 2021, USTR reallocated sugar from countries that have stated they do not plan to fill their FY 2021 allocated raw cane sugar quantities.
