

U.S. Sugar Monthly Import and Re-Exports

Fiscal Year (FY) 2023

November 2022

The November WASDE report shows FY 2023 WTO raw sugar tariff-rate quota (TRQ) shortfall projected at 254,632 short tons raw value, unchanged from last month. No information is available about specific countries.

The third tranche of the FY 2023 specialty sugar TRQ will open for 60,000 metric tons raw value on January 20, 2023. A valid specialty sugar certificate must accompany the imported sugar.
