

U.S. Sugar Monthly Import and Re-Exports

Fiscal Year (FY) 2024

February 2024

The February WASDE report shows FY 2024 WTO raw sugar tariff-rate quota (TRQ) shortfall is projected at 91,776 short tons raw value (STRV), unchanged from last month. No information is available about specific countries.

The fourth tranche of the FY 2024 specialty sugar TRQ will open for 40,000 metric tons raw value on April 15, 2024. A valid specialty sugar certificate must accompany the imported sugar.
