

U.S. Sugar Monthly Import and Re-Exports

Fiscal Year (FY) 2024

June 2024

The June WASDE report shows FY 2024 WTO raw sugar tariff-rate quota (TRQ) shortfall is projected at 44,100 short tons raw value (STRV), unchanged from last month. No information is available about specific countries.

FY 2025 WTO raw sugar TRQ shortfall is projected at 94,059 STRV. No information is available about specific countries.

The fifth and last tranche of the FY 2024 specialty sugar TRQ will open for 45,000 MTRV on July 15, 2024. A valid specialty sugar certificate must accompany the imported sugar.
